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CE-IT Community: Announces Public Comment for "Medical Device Integration Matrix"

The Clinical Engineering/Information Technology (CE-IT) Community is now accepting public comments on a matrix of potential questions facilities should ask vendors with respect to medical device integration. The Matrix has been developed into nine functional sections including: Vendor Information, Decision Chart, Security, Network, Hardware, Software & Interface, Human Factors, Service Support, Training and Documentation.

The CE-IT Community's Working Group 2, which is charged with providing resources and tools to help ease the integration of medical and information technologies, produced the document.
